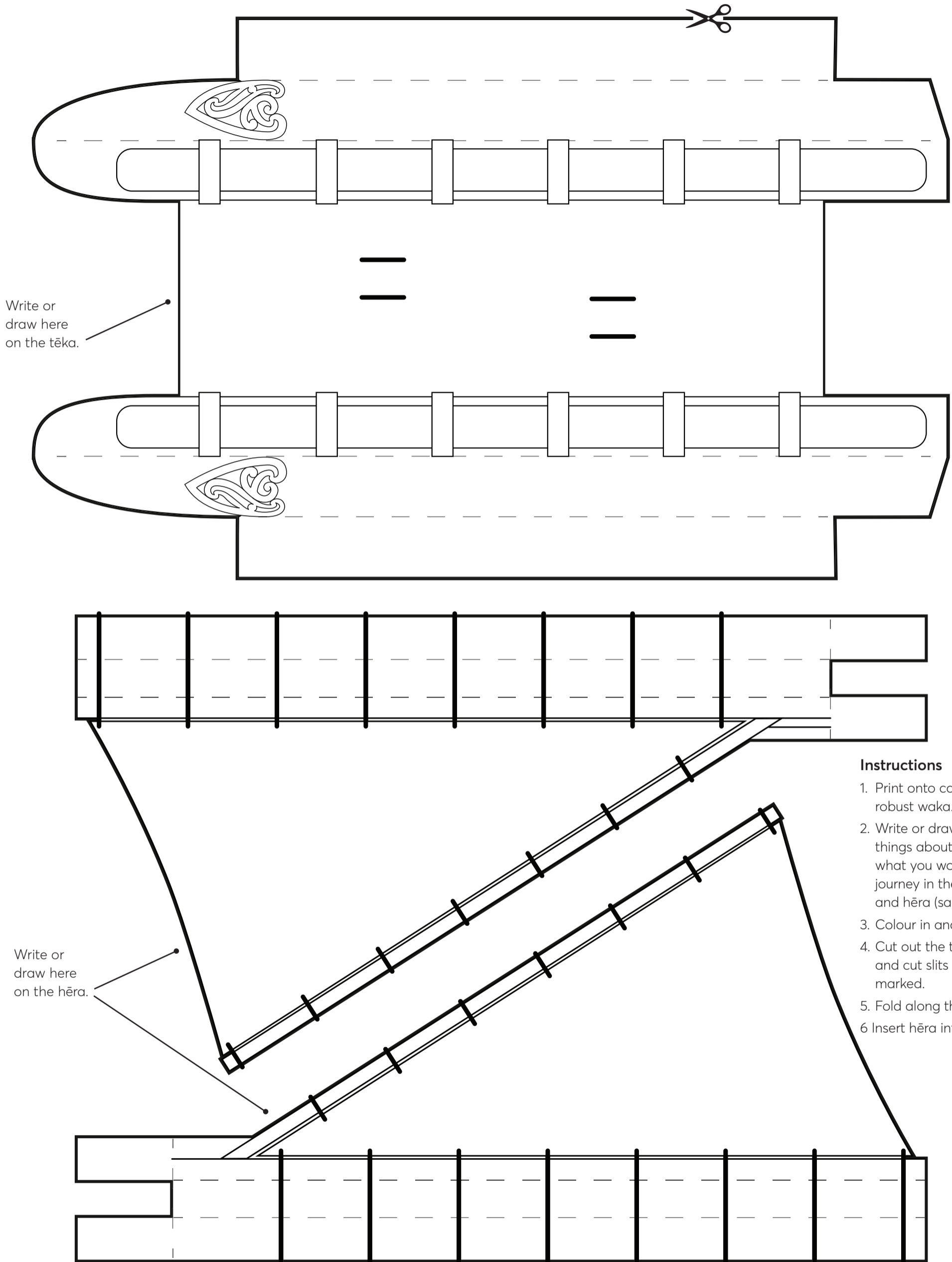


Your Journey Tō Haerenga

Instructions

1. Print onto card for a more robust waka.
2. Write or draw some of the things about you, and/or what you would take on a journey in the tēka (deck) and hēra (sails).
3. Colour in and decorate.
4. Cut out the three sections and cut slits in the tēka as marked.
5. Fold along the dotted lines.
6. Insert hēra into the slits.
