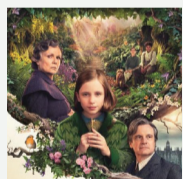

## Rutherford's Den

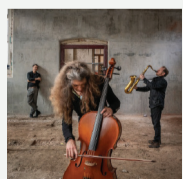

## String and rope-making with tī kōuka /cabbage tree leaves

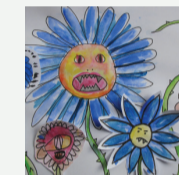

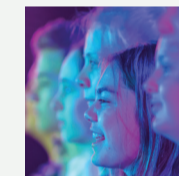


## Monster flower art

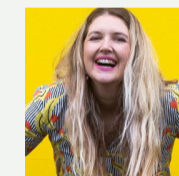
**Sunday 4 October | drop-in anytime between 10am - 4pm**
